<u>Acts 2:1-4 (NRSV)</u>

<sup>1</sup>When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. <sup>2</sup>And suddenly from heaven there came a sound like the rush of a violent wind, and it filled the entire house where they were sitting. <sup>3</sup>Divided tongues, as of fire, appeared among them, and a tongue rested on each of them. <sup>4</sup>All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit

*gave them ability.* As we come to the close of the Easter Season with Pentecost we consider again all the **expectations** 

As we come to the close of the Easter Season with Pentecost we consider again all the **expectations** and anticipations of the Apostles, the Jews, and the followers of Jesus. Again and again we find ourselves mystified by our errors in understanding God's intent and purposes even though we have the scriptures of the Prophets and even Jesus's own teaching describing just what God's plan is.

From the Ascension (Acts 1:1-11) when Jesus orders His disciples to remain in Jerusalem and await the promise of the Father, the Baptism of the Holy Spirit which is fulfilled at **Pentecost** (Acts 2:1-21) where we are told of the outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles, and how many in Jerusalem gathered around and witnessed the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. Who could have anticipated or expected or even comprehended all that occurs in this short amount of time.

Yet all of above events and those to come are what we consider the great fulfillment of God's plan for Jesus.

What a blessing to have been given to each of us by God through the Holy Spirit the following gifts: the utterance of wisdom; the utterance of knowledge; gifts of healing; working of miracles; the gift of prophecy; the discernment of spirits; speaking in various tongues and to another the interpretation of those tongues. All of these gifts are activated in us by the same Spirit, who allots to each of us individually as the Spirit chooses.

As we consider Pentecost and how the Holy Spirt rested on over five thousand people and gave them gifts/fruits of the Holy Spirit consider this. The Gifts of the Holy Spirit apply to all of His servants... throughout our Church, our community, the Missions Rivers District and the Virginia Conference as they ALL are part of HIS ministries.

I know none of you do the work for His Ministries here for earthly praise. However, I am so grateful for the work **you** do for Clarksbury in so many ways. THANK YOU...we are always praying for

your health  $\checkmark$  and YOUR servant hearts.

While praying and meditating this morning as I consider the Grapevine input for June, I just felt I need to tell ANYONE who has been involved in ANY of the ministries of our church and who is doing the work of the Lord that **no matter how insignificant YOU may feel that the work or service is**...know that many hands make light the work. So YES it is meant for YOU!


